Through its global and comparative emphasis, the programme aims primarily to engage students in examining different perspectives through humanity context and to reflect critically on its changing roles, forms and contents in today's society in which culture and commerce increasingly overlap with each other.

Scientific and Technological Literacy

Science and technology are a multi-faceted field of study which combines learning theories, change-management principles, learning technology, research methods, and pedagogical strategies. The programming language will be taught via a number of mathematical models in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Ecology, Statistics and Management. Some basic and important techniques in Calculus and Linear Algebra will also be covered.

Global Business in Asia (GBIA)

June 2018

The programme comprises of 2 weeks in Hong Kong and 2 weeks in Shanghai. Students will gain insights of contemporary global business environment in an Asian context through academic courses, group projects, together with visits to reputable corporations, quest speeches by industry leaders, as well as historical and cultural sightseeing tours.





Experiencing Creative Industries in Asia (ECIA)

June 17 - August 18, 2018

The 9-week internship programme will bring students to multi-locations in Asia. The seminar series in the first week is to deliver an overview of the corporate world and personnel systems in Hong Kong & China; while the programme will provide a cultural experience and enable students to develop their personal and professional network in Asia. Internship is guaranteed for all admitted participants.

Laboratory Exchange for Undergraduate and Research Postgraduate Students

July 16 - August 3, 2018

Jointly organised by the HKU Graduate School and HKU Summer Institute, the programme provides students with the opportunity to pursue research projects with world-class scientists of HKU on ground-breaking topics covering issues on engineering, medicine, chemistry, biology and physical chemistry.

This service learning programme will bring students a lifetime memorable experience where they can apply principles of leadership-in-service to make a positive impact.
