- Depending on the COVID-19 situation at the time of visa issuance, there is a possibility that visa issuance may be delayed or suspended, and students may not be able to obtain visas and participate in the program. In addition, there is a possibility that students will not be able to enter the country due to the strengthening of border control measures (i.e., denial of permission to enter Japan) by the Japanese government.
