OFFICIAL INVITATION AND VISA INFORMATION	
Important documents for obtaining student's official invitation	Copy of original signed passport valid for at least 6 months beyond stay. Student's passport must have at least 1 clear blank visa page available for the visa stamp(s).
Official invitation is issued by	The Russian Federal Migration Office.
Duration of issuing	30 to 90 days.
After the official invitation is ready	FEFU will send you the original by mail together with FEFU letter of acceptance.

After receiving the official invitation	Student must apply for visa in the nearest Russian embassy or consulate.
Number of entries granted by the visa issued by Russian embassy or consulate in your country	Single entry
Period validity of the visa issued by Russian embassy or consulate in your country	90 days
Visa extension	Exchange students have to extend their visa upon arrival in Vladivostok. Please contact FEFU International Office regarding the documents necessary for visa extension.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION	
Recommended arrival dates and time	February 24-25, 2023 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Arrival form	Please fill in and send the Arrival Form to the FEFU Inbound Exchange Coordinator not later than 3 week before arrival.
Free pick up service	Arranged by FEFU at arrival date. Please regard that pick up service is available just during recommended arrival dates and times. Please regard that several students from the same Home University should arrive as a group with the same flight. No separate pick up service is available for students from the same university.
Pick up and orientation	International students will be picked up by FEFU volunteer on the place of arrival. FEFU volunteers provide international students with linguistic support, necessary information about FEFU and Vladivostok life, help them by check-in in the dormitory and by settling other necessary formalities.

WARNING!

Due to the unstable epidemiological situation, the pickup service is temporarily not available. Students of the exchange program get to the university on their own.

After arrival at the FEFU campus, participants are placed in the quarantine area. Volunteers then guide the exchange students to take a PCR test. The cost of the test is ~ 1,800 rubles. The test takes approximately 1-2 days to be processed. After receiving a negative result, exchange students can move into their dormitories.
